Criteria for short listing of candidates for teaching skill test & interview:

1. The Scrutiny Committee will assess the marks of applicants in the in Academic Score on the basis of information provided by the candidate in the application.

2. *If the candidates are more than 10 for one post and 15 for two posts, then written examination the subject concerned will be conducted and the candidates will be shortlisted for teaching skill test and interview in a ratio of 10 times for one post followed by 05 times for each additional post by the University.

Step-II of Selection Process : The shortlisted will be called for Step II of selection process i.e. Teaching Skills test and interview and a topic will be allotted to each one of them on which they will have to make a power point presentation and present it before the Selection Committee members. After that, the Selection Committee will conduct the interview. Final selection will be based on the marks obtained by the candidate in teaching skill test and interview (20+10=30). The marks allotted for step II of selection process will be as follows :
